



Admissions Inventory – Bradford Campus

Please do not bring these types of items into the facility:

- Mesh or see through clothing
- Low-cut or inappropriate clothing
- Uniforms or scrub suits
- T-Shirts depicting drugs/alcohol or violence
- High Heels
- Curling irons, flat irons or hair dryers
- Nail polish or remover
- Glass containers (e.g., makeup)
- Scissors, knives, or weapons
- Games, cards, or posters
- Radios, pagers, cell phones, cameras, TVs, computers or any Internet enabled device (iPods / MP3 are permitted)
- Aerosol cans (pump sprays are allowed as long as they are alcohol-free)
- Cologne or perfume
- Opened tobacco products, loose tobacco, or rolling papers; all tobacco items must be manufacturer sealed
- No reservation cigarettes, chewing tobacco, vaporizers or e-cigarettes – **PER VERMONT LAW, VT S.86, SMOKING PERMITTED FOR INDIVIDUALS 21 YEARS OLD AND OLDER.**
- Bedding/Linens (sheets, pillows, blankets...)
- Towels
- Stuffed Toys
- Food (unopened gum or candy that is individually wrapped in an unopened package are permitted)
- Keys (Will be kept in security)
- Bandannas (Hats are allowed except in groups and at meal times)
- Pocket books, knapsacks, wallets, etc. (all luggage will be kept in Security)
- Shoe polish
- Lighters of any kind
- **No Money/Cash** - There is no reason to bring money or cash to the facility. If money is brought, it will be placed in the facility safe with very limited access.

You will need to bring these items with you into the facility:

- **A limit of two weeks worth of clothing**
- Appropriate clothing/seasonal footwear (i.e. Winter Boots, sneakers)
- Books-they will be okay with therapist approval
- Travel mugs with covers
- Non-toxic art supplies - optional (e.g., colored pencils)
- Toiletry items – including shampoo, conditioner, lotion, soap, toothpaste, toothbrush, hair products, feminine products, etc. (**Any products with alcohol in the first two ingredients will be kept in our hygiene closet.**)
- If you are allergic to specific laundry soap, please bring your own, unopened. No bleach.
- Any prescription medications that are taken daily or regularly should be brought with you at time of admission.

Upon arrival, you will be given a three-ring binder, which includes a notebook, pencil, loose-leaf paper & envelopes. Your own pens are permitted; any color other than black, as are stationary and stamps. Please do not bring your own envelopes and/or any stickers.
